ITINERARY FOR MARCH 2015 CALIFORNIA MISSIONS PILGRIMAGE

March 20: We begin our tour at Mission San Juan Capistrano with its beautifully landscaped grounds and ruins of the Great Stone Church and adjacent bell wall. We will visit Serra Chapel, the oldest operating church in California. Father Serra celebrated Mass in this chapel in 1783. We continue on to Mission San Gabriel an active Roman Catholic Church of the Los Angeles Archdiocese. Then on to San Fernando Rey de Espana located just north of Los Angeles. We will continue to Oxnard for dinner and overnight stay.

March 21: After breakfast we will visit Mission San Buenaventura that has been fully restored to its original form. We continue on to Mission Santa Barbara founded in 1786 and still inhabited by Franciscan friars. Our next stop is Mission Santa Ines founded in 1804 and perfectly restored. Our drive north continues to Morro Bay for dinner and 2 night stay.

March 22: After breakfast we will visit Mission San Luis Obispo de Tolosa, founded in 1772. California's fifth mission, often called "the Prince of Missions". We will then continue on to Mission San Miguel and return back to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

March 23: After breakfast we will visit Mission San Antonio de Padua the 3rd oldest church in California that is surrounded by wilderness. We will tour the Mission Church and sacred grounds. Then we will continue on to Mission San Carlos Borromeo del Rio Carmelo, the final resting place of Blessed Junipero Serra. Late in the afternoon we will check into our hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

March 24: After breakfast we will drive north through the Salinas Valley, the artichoke capital of the world, to the Mission San Juan Bautista, known for being the largest of the mission churches. We will then continue on to Mission Santa Cruz and then on to Mission Santa Clara, the first California Mission to be named in honor of a woman and the only one now located on a university campus. In the late afternoon we will check in to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

March 25: Return to Orange County
