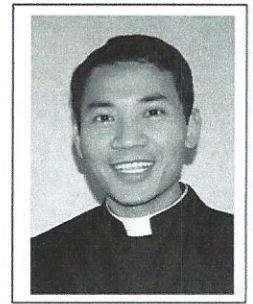

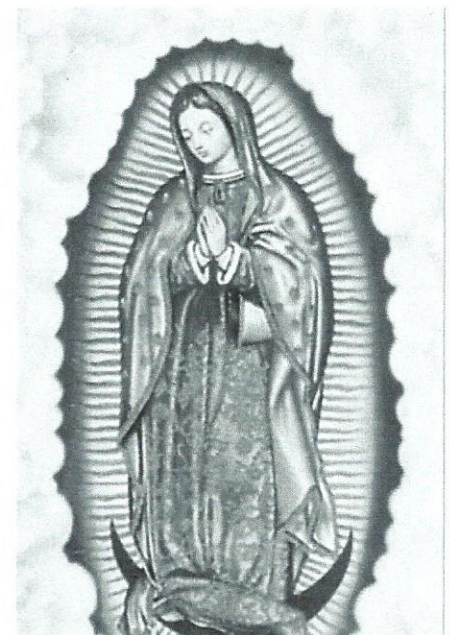

YOUR ITINERARY FOR ANNUAL TRIP TO MEXICO CITY

Day 1: Depart for **Mexico City**. Upon arrival we will be greeted by our local guide and transfer to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 2: After breakfast we will depart for our 20 minute drive to the **Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe**. Our tour guide will show us all four apparition sites and we will celebrate **Mass** at **Basilica of Guadalupe**. We will have time for lunch and shopping and return to our hotel in the late afternoon.

Day 3: After breakfast we will depart for the **Shrine San Miguel Del Milagro** the place where **St. Michael the Archangel** appeared to **Diego Lazaro** in 1631 and guided him to the grotto with the well of healing waters where many people are cured each year. View the image of **Our Lady** burned into a tree trunk after she appeared to **Juan Diego Bernardino** (no relation to Juan Diego of Guadalupe) in 1541. This image resides in the **Basilica of Our Lady of Ocotlan**. Five popes have granted approval of the apparition, giving devotional indulgences and elevating the **Church of Ocotlan** to a **Basilica** where we will celebrate **Mass**.

Day 4: After breakfast we will depart for **Holy Family Church in Mexico City** where we will celebrate **Mass** and visit the museum and tomb of our **Catholic hero, Blessed Miguel Pro** who died in 1927. (Before the trip, you can rent the movie *For the Greater Glory* that tells his story). There will be time for lunch, shopping and more sightseeing before returning to our hotel in the late afternoon.

Day 5: After breakfast we will depart for a visit to **Coyoacan** an artistic and cultural area where we will celebrate **Mass** in the beautiful **Church of San Jose**. We will also visit **Iglesia de San Juan Bautista**. There will be time for lunch and shopping.

Day 6: After breakfast we will depart for the airport for our return flight home. *Vaya con DIOS!*

Story of our Lady of Guadalupe:

On December 9, 1531, a native Mexican named Juan Diego rose before dawn to walk to daily Mass in what is now Mexico City. As he passed Tepeyac Hill, he heard music and saw a glowing cloud encircled by a rainbow. A woman's voice called him to the top of the hill. There he saw a beautiful young woman dressed like an Aztec princess. She said she was the Virgin Mary and asked Juan to tell the bishop to build a church on that site. She said, "I vividly desire that a church be built on this site, so that in it I can be present and give my love, compassion, help, and defense, for I am your most devoted mother . . .
