

He has a PhD in Sociology and a Post-Doctorate in Marriage and Family Therapy and Individual Psychotherapy. He has taught at several Universities in the areas of sociology, psychology, and marriage and family relations, and psychotherapy. He has spent over 30 years doing marriage and family and individual counseling. He has been active in evangelization and the healing ministry throughout the world. He is a frequent guest on Immaculate Heart Radio, 97.1 FM. Fr. Struzzo will explain the purpose of suffering in our daily lives and how to receive the graces needed to overcome it. He will bless everyone with a relic of the True Cross.

Ellen Severoni, Over the past 20 years, Ellen's spiritual path has included several activities in pursuit of a strong connection to her Catholic faith, her church, and her community.
