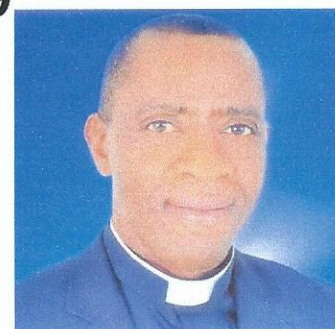

Lu Cortese, is the Executive Director of St. Joseph Evangelization Network-St. Joseph Radio, located in St. Charles, Missouri and Orange County, California. It is a world-wide network of teaching and evangelization via radio, TV, production, presentations and publishing materials. What started 35 years ago in Southern California developed into a world-wide ministry heard on EWTN for 25 years and other Catholic radio affiliates throughout the country. Her motto throughout this time has been: "Changing the world, one soul at a time."

Lu's amazing personal journey includes trials of life, marriage and mission. A woman in a man's world, she will discuss its challenges, trials, and rewards, and how "letting go and letting God" resulted in powerful miracles of conversion and faith. The personal encounters which transformed her life have inspired listeners to persevere in all things in spite of the struggle, for all things are possible with God. Although Lu is a former Catholic Woman of the Year nominee for the Diocese of Orange, CA, as well as the recipient of the Cardinal Mindszenty Freedom Award, she is most proud of being the mother of 2 sons and grandmother of 18.
