View the image of **Our Lady** burned into a tree trunk after she appeared to Juan Diego Bernardino (no relation to **Juan Diego of Guadalupe**) in 1541. This image resides in the **Basilica of Our Lady of Ocotlan. Five Popes** have granted approval of the apparition, giving devotional indulgences and elevating the **Church of Ocotlan** to a **Basilica.** Here we will **celebrate Holy Mass**.

<u>Day 4:</u> After breakfast we will depart for **Holy Family Church** in **Mexico City** where we will celebrate Mass and visit the museum and tomb of our **Catholic hero**, **Blessed Miguel Pro** who died a martyr's death in 1927. We also will visit the church that **Juan Diego** attended and was baptized in. More time for sightseeing and shopping before returning to our hotel in the late afternoon.

<u>Day 5:</u> After breakfast we will depart for a visit to **Coyoacan** an artistic and cultural area where we will **celebrate Holy Mass** in the **Church of San Juan Bautista** surrounded by beautiful gardens. There he saw a beautiful young woman dressed like an Aztec princess. She said she was the Virgin Mary and asked Juan to tell the bishop to build a church on that site. She said, "I vividly desire that a church be built on this site, so that in it I can be present and give my love, compassion, help and defense, for I am your most devoted mother...
