YOUR DAILY ITINERARY

- Jul. 30: Depart LAX for Split. Arrive next day. Meals served onboard your transatlantic flight.
- <u>Jul. 31:</u> Arrive in Split in the afternoon. We will begin our 2 1/2 hour bus drive to Medjugorje which has beautiful scenic views of the Adriatic Sea and picturesque mountains. Arrive in evening for dinner and overnight.
- Aug. 1: After a leisurely breakfast we will depart at 9:00 AM for Mostar. This town combines Asian and Western architecture and mosques, Catholic churches and a cathedral. Upon our arrival we will take a short bus tour of the city, celebrate Mass and then visit the famous bridge built in 1566 and destroyed in 1993 and rebuilt in 2006. Many famous people came for the opening ceremony of the new bridge, such as Prince Charles of England, Luciano Pavarotti and others. Return to Medjugorje for Opening Ceremony of the Festival.
- Aug. 2 Aug. 5: The full-day programs will begin at 9 AM every day. Each day will consist of Mass, prayers, impressive lectures, powerful testimonies and many musical performances featuring dance. There will be a welcome greeting for each country in their native language. The complete programs will be simultaneously translated by interpreters in English and listened to through small transistor radios. Hundreds of priests will concelebrate Mass. A candlelight procession will take place through the village. Thousands of young people attend the Youth Festival every year.
- Aug. 6: After a leisurely breakfast we will depart for Split and stop in Veprec Sanctuary, a replica of Lourdes. We will then continue on to Makarska Riveria and explore this lovely beach town and enjoy an early dinner overlooking the beautiful Adriatic Sea. After dinner we will continue on to Split (less than an hour drive) for our two night stay.
- Aug. 7: After breakfast we will visit the medieval town of Trogir next to Split, which is known for its museums, arts and beautiful beaches. Trogar is the best-preserved Romanesque-Gothic complex not only in the Adriatic, but in all of Central Europe. There will be time for lunch and shopping. In the late afternoon we will return to our hotel in Split for dinner and overnight stay.
- Aug. 8: Depart for hometown, USA.
