

ITINERARY TO ROME, ASSISI AND SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

- Day 1 (Sept. 28): Depart U.S.A. for Rome, Italy. Meals are served onboard transatlantic flight.
- Day 2 (Sept. 29): Upon arrival in Rome, we will be greeted by our tour director and board our private bus to take us to Assisi for a 3-night stay. On the way to our hotel, we will stop and visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli and see the small Portiuncula chapel where St. Francis died. We will check into our hotel for dinner and overnight stay.
- Day 3 (Sept. 30): This morning we will visit the Basilica of St. Francis which contains many of the saint's possessions, his tomb and the tombs of some of his brothers. We will visit the church of San Rufino, where Francis and Clare were baptized and the Church of St. Clare to see her incorrupt body and the original San Damiano Cross that spoke to Francis. Some free time before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.
- **Day 4 (Oct. 1):** Today we will have an excursion to visit the **National Shrine of St. Rita of Cascia** to view her incorrupt body. She is called the patron saint of the impossible (please bring your prayer petitions). We also will view the cross where she received the stigmata of the thorn on her forehead. For more information, please visit her website: www.SaintRitaShrine.org.
- Day 5 (Oct. 2): This morning we depart Assisi for San Giovanni Rotondo. On the way, we will stop in Lanciano to view the Eucharistic Miracle that is the real flesh and blood of Jesus that has been there for 12 centuries unchanged. Then we continue towards San Giovanni Rotondo for our two-night stay.
- Day 6 (Oct. 3): After breakfast we will visit Monte Sant'Angelo and the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel that he consecrated himself in 490 A.D. Popes and saints have visited this site requesting St. Michael's intercession. We will return to San Giovanni Rotondo and visit the shrine of Padre Pio where we will have Mass and visit his tomb and view his incorrupt body. We will also tour the sanctuary; see the old church and crucifix from which he received the stigmata in 1918. We will return to our hotel for dinner and overnight stay.
- Day 7 (Oct. 4): This morning we will depart San Giovanni Rotondo for Rome and on the way visit Benedictine Abbey, where St. Benedict is buried in Montecasino. We will arrive in Rome in the late afternoon and have some free time before dinner and our overnight stay.
- Day 8 (Oct. 5): This morning we will tour St. John Lateran Church followed by the Basilicas of St. Mary Major and St. Paul. Some free time to explore and shop.
- **Day 9 (Oct. 6):** After breakfast, we depart for the **Vatican** and visit St. Peter Basilica. At noon, Holy Father will pray Angelus with people present at the St. Peter Square. He will bless everyone. Afternoon, we will be free to explore on your own. 5PM we will return to our hotel.
- Day 10 (Oct. 7): Depart Rome for Hometown, USA. Ciao! Ciao! Have a blessed trip home!
